### **JOB SUMMARY**

The Registered Nurse (RN) is part of an interdisciplinary team that provides consultation, direct care, capacity enhancement and support to older adults (and their partners in care), living in the community; within the geographical boundaries of York Region and South Simcoe. The RN is expected to ensure the safety and security of the client(s) environment, to practice in accordance with College of Nurses of Ontario professional standards, and the policies and procedures as defined by LOFT Community Services. The RN will be responsible for working with individuals from diverse backgrounds, contributing to Integrated Psychogeriatric Outreach Program development, participating in clinical supervision; and providing support to the physical, cognitive, mental health and social/recreational needs of older adults and seniors in a way that enhances their dignity and personal empowerment. The RN is directly responsible for developing and articulating strategies for the management of recovery, psychosocial rehabilitation and coordination of care using information collected through assessments and collaboration with the integrated care team. Additionally, this role will liaise with community agencies, other practitioners and key partners, including caregivers, to coordinate care for clients.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Valid registration and in good standing with the College of Nurses of Ontario;
- Nursing practice specialty in Certified Psychiatric and Mental Health Nurse (CPMHN(C)) required; Valid CPR certificate;
- Minimum three (3) years' experience working with vulnerable older adults and seniors with serious mental illness, cognitive, addiction and responsive behavioural challenges;
- Experience with vulnerable older adults and seniors with serious mental illness, cognitive, addiction and responsive behavioural challenges;
- Knowledge of social services, community resources and the continuum of supports for seniors;
- Current BCLS/CPR certification required;
- An understanding of recovery and psychosocial rehabilitation principles and the therapeutic relationship;
- Well-developed problem solving abilities and interpersonal skills;
- Self-directed, results oriented and capable of working independently as well as in a team environment;
- Good oral and written communication skills and computer literacy;
- Excellent assessment skills, including demonstrated knowledge of crisis intervention skills;
- Demonstrated ability to provide individual/group health teaching to clients, caregivers and other care providers;
- Ability to collaborate effectively with other members of inter-professional care teams, clients, family members and community team members;
- Demonstrates awareness and understanding in working with individuals from different cultures;
